- Efficiency
 - Using the same diagnostic platforms increases the capacity and capability
 - In some cases, reduced cost of testing
 - Integrated 24/7/365 teams on duty
- Faster response and risk assessment
 - Emerging infections with a zoonotic potential
 - Influenza
 - One influenza laboratory covering avian flu, swine flu and human influenza
- Opportunities for comparative research
 - Understanding disease processes by comparing between species, and translating experiences from one species to another
 - Vaccine research including vaccines for infections in swine




